The Office of the DC Mayor announced today that the vaccine mandate will no longer be in effect, starting tomorrow, February 15th. We have confirmed with the Walter E Convention Center, that this means, for the 2022 Capitol Hill Classic, we will no longer be required to check for COVID status for any person entering the tournament, this includes players, coaches, and spectators.

- For player entry, players should simply enter through the player and coach lines wearing their uniform.
- For coach entry, coaches should simply show their QR code with photo ID at the player and coach lines.
- For spectator entry, spectators should show their purchased QR code with Photo ID at the spectator lines.

There will be two entrances-- Mt Vernon and the Marquis Connector-- and both entrances are open to players, coaches, and spectators for the entirety of the tournament-- Saturday, Sunday, and Monday. Please follow signage once you arrive.

Tickets have now re-opened for purchase. Daily passes are available for \$18 per day plus processing fees. There is not a weekend pass available for purchase. You can purchase tickets on our website.

Please note, the DC mask mandate is still in effect through February 28th, 2022 so everyone entering the building will be required to wear a mask. Players actively playing on the court may choose to remove it.
